### Into the Wild Reading Instructions

**Reading Assignment:** For every two chapters, complete all of the following:

### A. Précis Summary

- 1st Sentence
  - Identification of the chapters
  - accurate "says" verb + "that" clause
  - author's main assertion (either paraphrased or directly quoted)
- 2nd Sentence
  - Author's support for the main assertion; listed chronologically.
  - Minimum of 3-4 supports
  - Insert another paraphrase of the author's main message

- 3rd Sentence
  - Analyze the author's purpose using an "in order to" phrase (purpose=what the author wants their targeted audience to think, believe, do, or feel after reading the piece)
- 4th Sentence
  - State who the targeted audience is

     + another paraphrase of the
     author's argument and/or what the
     relationship is between the author
     and audience through author's
     tone.
- B. Write **WiTW Questions**: 2 questions per chapter that come from your confusion about the text. (things you didn't understand and need clarified). Note the page number where the question arose from.
- C. **Note insights**—at least one insight from each chapter that answer this: what is the text NOT saying that is significant or important to understand? Think larger social implications, author's purpose, character analysis, ideas about life... Note the page number where the insight arose from.
