3. Analyze the author's purpose using an "in order to" phrase (purpose = what the author wants their targeted audience to think, believe, do, or feel after reading the piece)

4. State who the targeted audience is + another paraphrase of the author's argument and/or what the relationship is between the author and audience through author's tone.
